WHAT IS GSD?

The Adult Education (AE) sector plays a key role in addressing both perspectives of learning sustainability: the individual (Sustainability Literacy) and the community (Sustainable Development) level. There is a lack of innovative and appropriate educational programmes to bring about skills and competence for sustainable behaviour and development for adults who learn in different contexts.

The Generators for Sustainable Development project will create consciousness and enable the adult learner to change behaviour and to become active for sustainability (SL) and create SD projects on local community levels, for instance by implementing a green project, by improving a specific situation or by supporting certain members of the community.



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PROJECT PROGRESS

The partnership was working on the R1 GSD Inventory, an open and growing catalogue of materials, learning units, tools, and resources to promote Sustainability Literacy. Each partner country collected and reported 15 good examples of sustainable development in adult education.

The GSD partnership has started applying the GSD planning pack (R2) within the Continuing Professional Development Programme (R3) of the AE professionals. Later, it will be transferred in the pilot phase within R3, when the professionals will apply the planning pack and further develop it within their sustainability pilot projects in different contexts.



TRANSNATIONAL MEETING

On the 26-27th of January 2023, the project partner Smart Revolution organized the second TPM in Turin, Italy. During the meeting, the partnership set goals for implementing three project results, namely for Inventory, Planning Pack, and CPD Programme.

In addition, all partner countries agreed to conduct the LTTA during the REVEAL Exhibition and Conference week from the 12th to the 16th of June 2023 in Göttingen. Each country should bring three trainers for the training in order to make the AE professionals competent in the field of SL&SD.
